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## **Mount Vernon Educational Foundation Raising Funds for MVCSD Students in Need of Laptops**

**MOUNT VERNON, N.Y.** (April 9, 2020) — The Mount Vernon Educational Foundation (MVEF) is calling for donations to help raise money to purchase laptops for the students in the Mount Vernon City School District who are in need of devices as they continue to learn at home.

The planned goals of the Foundation are to provide opportunities for students that enhance learning while delivering programs and opportunities beyond the classroom, such as extending the District's robotics program and taking educational trips.

"We are excited to partner with the Mount Vernon Educational Foundation to continue to expand our efforts to ensure every student has an equitable opportunity for success by way of a digital device," Superintendent Kenneth R. Hamilton said. "We are appreciative of the Foundation's support and its mission to expand the education of students in the School District by giving them new and different learning opportunities."

Justino said of the current campaign for laptop funding: "Every gift, no matter the size, will have an immediate impact on a child's ability to learn in this new virtual environment. Now, more than ever, it is critical that our children have the resources they need to continue their education."
